PROGRAMS & EVENTS | JANUARY 2025

STORY TIME: 0-6. RPL Story Times are held Tuesdays at 10:30 AM. Designed for babies through preschooler, Story Time helps introduce children (and their grown-ups) to books and promotes a lifelong love of reading through sensory exploration, art, movement, and play!

RHYME TIME: Ages Birth – 2. RPL Rhyme Times are held Wednesdays at 10:30 AM. Designed for babies and toddlers, and/or children at this developmental stage, Rhyme Time is a playgroup designed to help young children build important early learning skills through rhyme, movement, games, and sensory play. We encourage caregivers to come prepared to sit with your child on your lap or bring a blanket for your baby to lay on.

HEAD START STORY TIME: Students from the Ridgway *Northern Tier Head Start* class will be participating in a story time on Friday, 1/10 at 10:00am in the Children's Room. A craft will follow. The Children's Room is reserved during this time.
