SUMMER READING 2024: Our Summer Reading program is a part of a national initiative designed to encourage families to continue reading across the non-academic summer months. Readers set reading goals, track their progress, and participate in story times and other literacy activities. All of our programs are FREE to participate for readers in our region, but registration is required. Visit ridgwaylibrary.org to learn more and sign up!

STORY TIME: Ages Birth – 9. RPL Summer Reading Story Times are held Tuesdays and Wednesdays at 10:30 AM. Designed for family and independent readers aged birth through 9, our SRP Story Times feature a story, an activity, and a craft each week, along with games, prizes, and more!

RHYME TIME: Ages Birth – 2. RPL Summer Reading Rhyme Times are held Fridays at 10:30 AM. Designed for babies and toddlers, and/or children at this developmental stage, Rhyme Time is a playgroup designed to help young children build important early learning skills through rhyme, movement, games, and sensory play. We encourage caregivers to come prepared to sit with your child on your lap or bring a blanket for your baby to lay on. Meet other caregivers in your neighborhood and promote early literacy at home!

TWEEN MAKER STUDIO: Ages 10-18. Teens and tweens ages 10-18 can join us Tuesdays at 1:00PM for our Tween Maker Studio. Work through a weekly craft at your own pace while enjoying the library's newly-renovated interior and beautiful garden space. Grab some friends, sign in at the circulation desk, and find a comfy spot to create.

LEGO CLUB: Ages 6-10. Elementary-aged kids can join us Wednesdays at 1:00PM for LEGO Club. Featuring LEGO challenges as well as self-directed play, LEGO Club is a fun way to meet other builders and learn new tricks. Please note: all children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult for the duration of RPL programming.
