PROGRAMS & EVENTS | MARCH 2025

CINCH TOURNAMENT: Sunday, March 2nd at noon. Join us Sunday, March 2nd at noon at The Royal Inn to play Elk County's favorite card game—cinch! \$20 buys you lunch and a chance to win big while supporting a great cause. We ask that you register in advance, though we will accept walk-ins at the door *if* you bring a group of 4. Call or stop by the library to reserve a spot; you can pay ahead or at the door on the day of our event.

BEGINNER FLY TYING WITH TROUT UNLIMITED: Beginning Tuesday, February 4th and running each Tuesday for 6 weeks; 7:00 – 8:30PM. Learn to tie your own flies in this FREE 6-week course designed for new and experienced fisherman. Registration is required; this program is currently **FULL**.

STORY TIME: 0-6. RPL Story Times are held Tuesdays at 10:30 AM. Designed for babies through preschooler, Story Time helps introduce children (and their grown-ups) to books and promotes a lifelong love of reading through sensory exploration, art, movement, and play!

RHYME TIME: Ages Birth – 2. RPL Rhyme Times are held Wednesdays at 10:30 AM. Designed for babies and toddlers, and/or children at this developmental stage, Rhyme Time is a playgroup designed to help young children build important early learning skills through rhyme, movement, games, and sensory play. We encourage caregivers to come prepared to sit with your child on your lap or bring a blanket for your baby to lay on.

HEAD START STORY TIME: Students from the Ridgway *Northern Tier Head Start* class will be participating in a story time on Friday, 3/14 at 10:00am in the Children's Room. A craft will follow. The Children's Room is reserved during this time.

FAMILY STORY TIME: Ages Birth – 10. Join us Saturday, March 22nd at 11AM for our World Down Syndrome Day celebration! Each year, the world celebrates Down Syndrome Day on March 21st in honor of the fact that people with down syndrome have an extra 21st chromosome. Along the way, the idea of wearing mismatched or unique socks has caught on, both in homage to the fact that socks kind of look like chromosomes *and* because wearing odd socks is a way to express acceptance of differences and celebrate being unique. We'll be Rocking Our Socks at RPL with some sock painting fun *and* a Best Sock Competition! The person to wear the best combination of unique socks will win a bookish prize. Family Story Times are held once monthly for kids ages birth through 10 and their families. Featuring a longer Story Time and a bigger activity or craft, Family Story Time is a great way to spend time together as a family — reading, creating, and getting to know your local library.

NEEDLEWORK CLUB: Our needlework club is an all-ages event that will be hosted by the library on the second Monday of every month. This informal, social meeting is a chance to chat and share fiber arts tips over coffee and tea with other interested needleworkers. Beginner through expert level knitters, crocheters, folks who work with a loom, and other yarn-based artists are all welcome to attend.
